Kudos to One of our Own

A San Antonio-based roofing company has been recognized for its work with the nation's galactic exploration agency: NASA.

Cram Roofing Inc. was recently named runner-up for the Contractor of the Year award by the NASA Kennedy Space Center in Florida. Cram was recognized for a project that called for re-roofing the Kennedy Space Center's Communication Facility at Cape Canaveral.
