CRAM ROOFING RECEIVES TWO MAJOR GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS

Department of the Navy and U.S Dept. of Justice UNICOR Federal Prison Industries

San Antonio, TX - September 13, 2010 – Cram Roofing Company, Inc., based in San Antonio, has been selected by the Department of the Navy in a \$100,000,000 Multiple Award Construction Contract (MACC) along with five other contractors for general roofing projects in North Carolina including Camp Lejeune and Cherry Point. The base year is Sept. 9, 2010 – 2011 and if all options are exercised the MACC will extend through 2015.

Cram was also awarded a contract to regionally participate in the multi-million dollar National Roofing IDIQ Contract for UNICOR Federal Prison Industries along with four other contractors. The multi-state contract was effective July 23, 2010 for a base year with three one-year option periods.
